# Funding for 2018



For the year 2018, the Thomas Weiland Foundation will be awarding up to

## eight scholarships for master's students.

The funding will be provided beginning 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 (summer semester) and 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018 (winter semester), respectively.

### **Application deadlines**

31st December 2017 (if beginning a master's degree course in summer semester 2018)

30<sup>th</sup> June 2018 (if beginning a master's degree course in winter semester 2018/19)

#### 1. Requirements for Funding

Funding will be provided to students who have achieved outstanding results while obtaining their bachelor's degrees and will be beginning a STEM<sup>1</sup>-related master's degree course at Technische Universität Darmstadt in the respective semesters (1. subject-related semester).

### 2. Application Procedure

Students can apply for funding from the Foundation in wrting. The following documents must be submitted:

- Letter of application which describes the applicant's education so far, future educational plans, and their significance to the STEM field
- CV and documents showing the applicant's most important school and academic achievements, as well as any contributions to socially worthy projects.
- Transcript of all university course marks including applicant's ranking within the course for the year or semester of graduation (statement of ranking usually issued by course or examination office).

The students will be informed whether their application has been approved by mid-February (applications for summer semester) or mid-August (applications for winter semester).

### 3. How Funding is Provided

Funding is provided as a **scholarship over the course of four semesters**. In this period, recipients will be awarded an amount of

### 500 euro per month.

Only students who are enrolled at the Technische Universität Darmstadt while receiving funding are eligible. This means that students are eligible if they are already enrolled at the Technische Universität Darmstadt or if they are enrolled at another university but planning to begin a master's course at the University in Darmstadt.

Students who exmatriculate will no longer receive funding. In addition, students are to inform the Foundation of their academic progress each semester. If recipients fail to make progress according to their degree course scheme without having a good reason, the Trustees may terminate funding.

### 4. Funding Approval

The Advisory Council of the Thomas Weiland Foundation are responsible for approving funding applications based on the Foundation's funding guidelines.
